

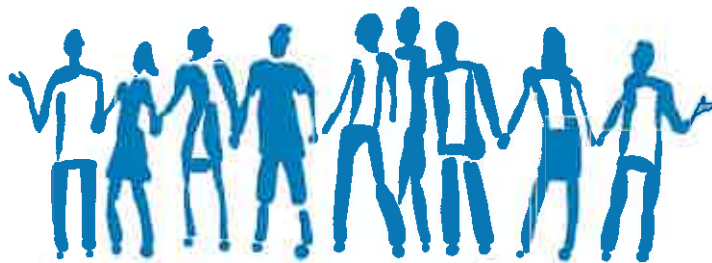

Walk in wisdom toward those who are outside..

Sunday morning, Doug Milligan challenged the Hillcrest congregation with these Bible verses in Colossians 4:2-6. His challenge was not only sowing the seed, praying that God will open doors but the congregation would be prepared to speak about Christ when that door opened and they were asked about Christ. There were 33 people at the workshop on Saturday and 17 were from four other congregations. The Cottdale congregation who hosted this same workshop five years and has been a great supporter of Hillcrest and their efforts to establish a church in this area of Tuscaloosa. Br Milligan stressed the importance of as they, "Walk in wisdom....." they must be prepared to teach the lost and they bought 26 set of Bibles and will have a teaching class to for those who were not able to attend the workshop. They must be prepared to 'reach and teach' the lost June 7-14 but Doug emphasized they can not wait until June they must start the 'reaching and teaching' NOW.

This was a great workshop because the congregation had notified all the congregations in Tuscaloosa and invited them to attend. Several of the men including Dupree Galloway and Junior Latner from Cottdale met during the workshop to develop a plan to get the other congregations to participate in the commitment to reach all the lost in Tuscaloosa and the prayer is the same as in Acts17:6: "These who have turned the world upside down have come here too." Terry organized the workshop and had these helpers; John Alexander, Linda Owens, Carolle Bump, Russ & Judy Blackwell, Wynell Ardis and Hilda Hester for to helping spread the Word. Junior and Karen Latner attended the Bible Class and were a great help in encouraging others. We had a special boost when Raegan McInnish joined us for worship services and stayed afterwards to help encourage the visitors.

This is a small growing congregation and they need our help to knock doors, encourage members and teach Bible studies. We need you to pray for this effort and the Hillcrest congregation. We a have Back to the Bible Workshop scheduled for March 2, Saturday from 8:00-4:00 and encourage to sign up and learn how to teach the lost of this world not only in Tuscaloosa but in your own family.
