Some of us may look at ourselves and think, "What good am I to God?" Some of us may look around at others who are so very skilled and think, "I'll never be as good as them! What good am I to God?" Some of us may look at Christians who seem to know so much and have the Bible practically memorized and think to ourselves, "I will never know as much as they do! I feel like such a dummy when it comes to the Bible! What good am I to God? Look at the men and women God used, Like Ester, Gideon and Peter— God used him! 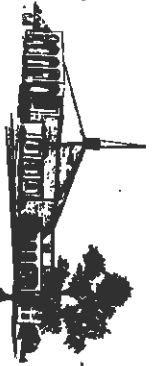
