If you have traveled anywhere you realize how blessed we are to live where we live with the lives we have. In reading God's Word (Heb 13:16) it puts in all in perspective: the blessed lives we have and the opportunities that go with it. The congregation worshipping at 303 Cox Blvd in Sheffield, Alabama has seven elders who this year will have over 156 years experience as elders. Their love for the Lord, your Soul and your family's souls are paramount in everything they do. Most members realize the sacrifices (Heb 13:17) that come with being an elder but those sacrifices are made with joy and love for their brethren and their families. The book of Hebrews is full of challenges and rewards for us as individuals and our families. Sharing God's Word with the lost has been the thread running throughout Cox Blvd's commitment to evangelism; sometimes that lost soul is not on the outside but sitting in front, behind or next to us at worship services.... being an example, an encourager and always ready to answer any of their questions.

The congregation rejoiced in the baptisms of two precious souls in Madison Cassel and Samuel Rogers along with their parents and family. This sharing takes place in so many ways with finances, benevolence, donations of time and food and studying the Bible with the lost. With almost 40 different programs that reach out to others there is a great need for more helpers to reap what is waiting for someone to knock their door or simply say..."Do you have any questions about our services?". We are blessed because God gave us the Holy Spirit as a gift for being baptized (Acts 2:38) but with that comes the responsibility to study God's Word even more to learn more so we can help others understand why Christ died such a horrible and painful death. When we put on Jesus Christ in baptism this conversion is turning from sin and toward God. 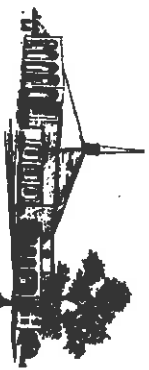
