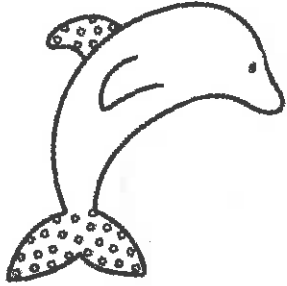


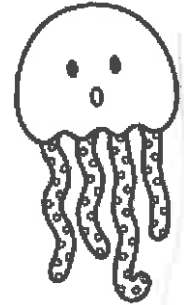

Sunday Night: Wayne Kilpatrick (Heritage Place Church of Christ)

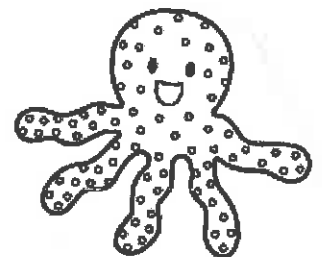
Monday Night: Kirk Brothers (Heritage Christian University)

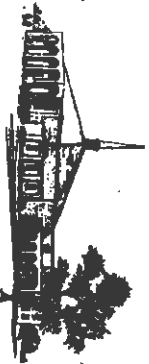
