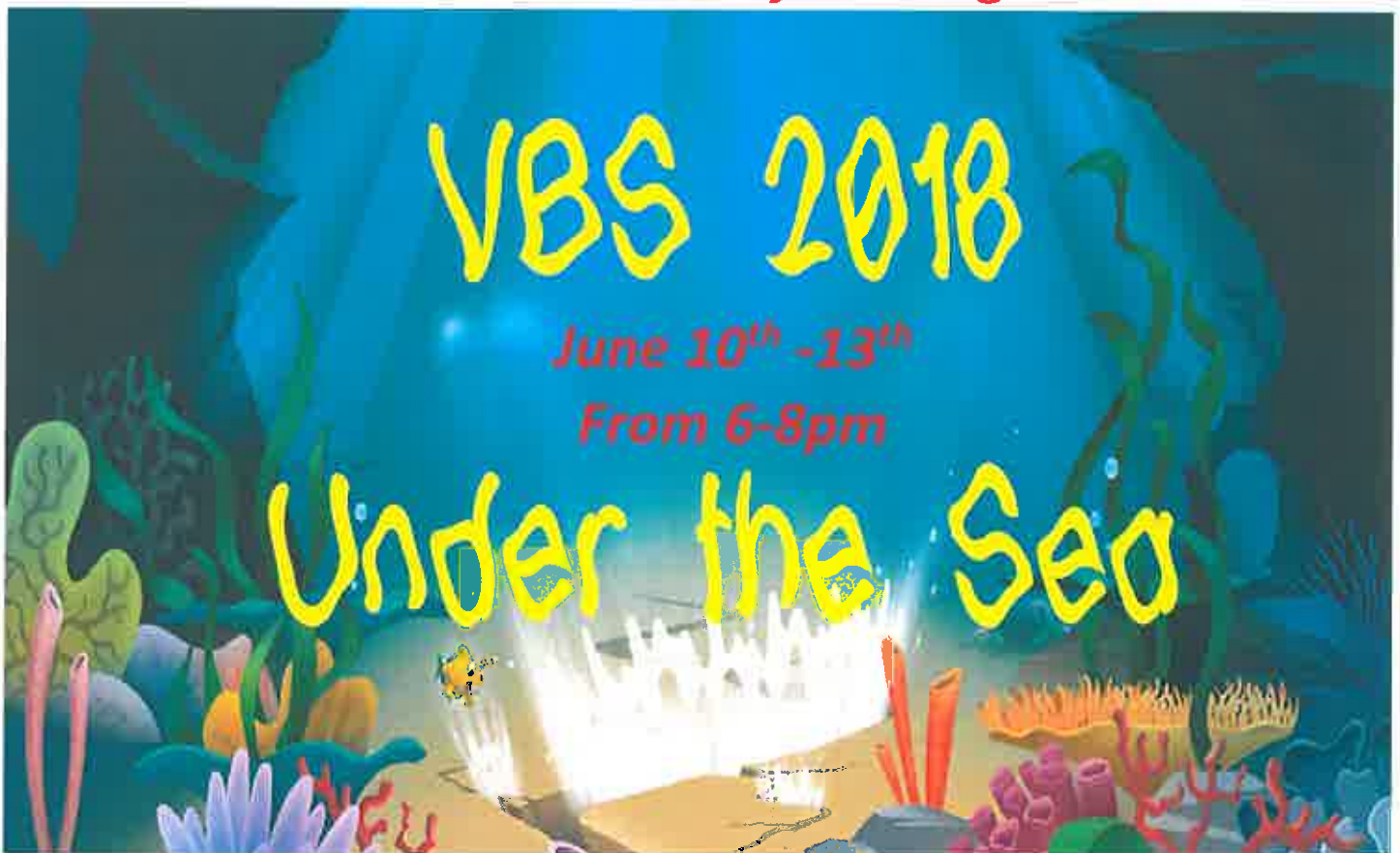


SKY ZONE[®] TRAMPOLINE PARK

Sign-up sheet is on bulletin board.

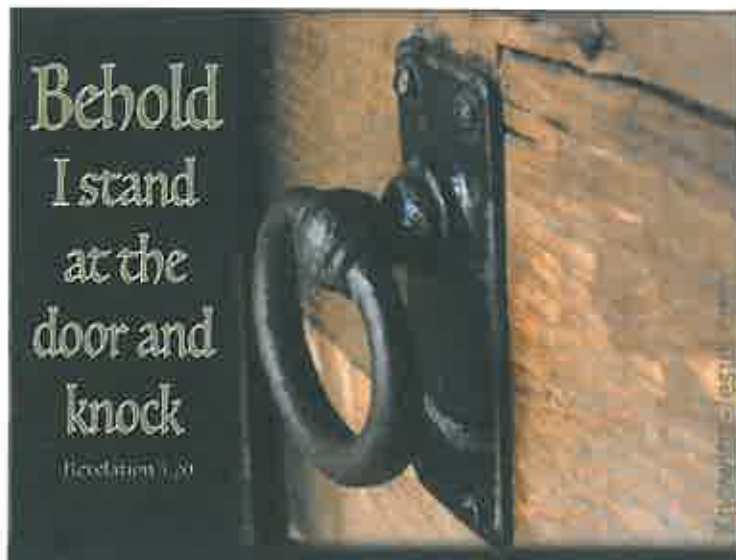

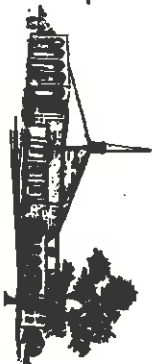
